“For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.” -Jesus

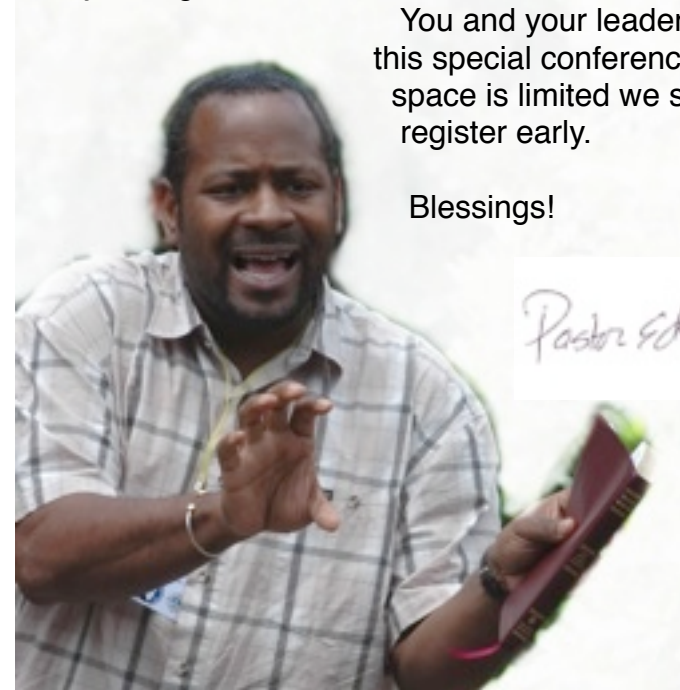
Dear Church Leader,

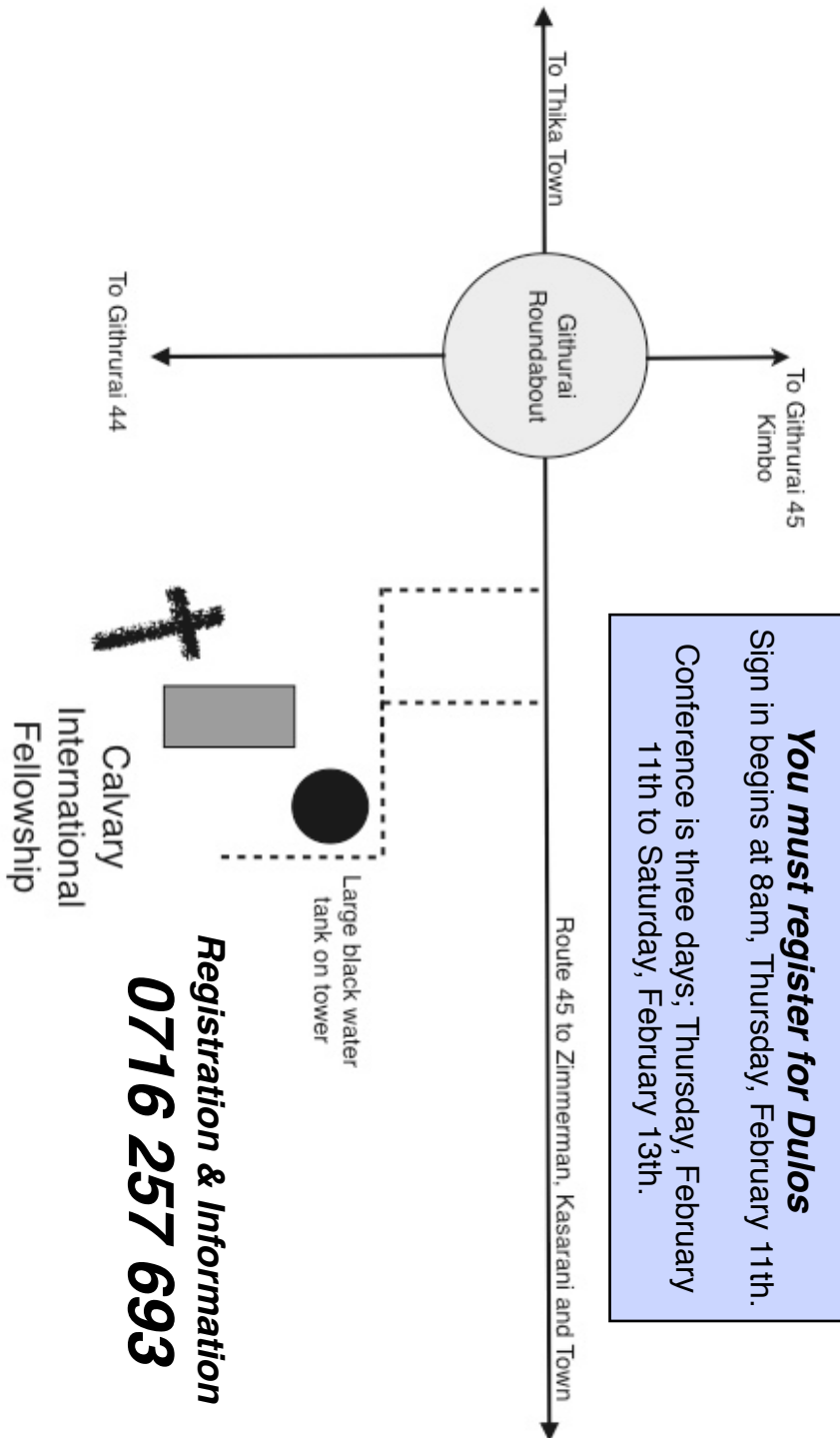
Dulos will be what the Bible says concerning leading the family God gave us and the church Jesus built and died for.

Some common questions about *Dulos*...

Who is Dulos for? Who is invited?

Dulos is a leadership conference for pastors, overseers (bishops), elders, deacons and other ministry leaders within local churches.

What is the theme and topics of the Dulos conference?

Dulos is themed on teaching servant leadership with key verse being Mark 10:45. Pastor Tony and others will teach verse by verse through books of the Bible to teach key points of servant style leadership for the church and in the family of church leaders. Though many topics will be covered in expository style, there will also be time for questions and answers.

Are women invited to Dulos?

Yes! Pastors wives and women overseeing ministry are encouraged to come to **Dulos**. Morning sessions will be for everyone, but afternoon sessions will be separated for special teaching for ladies.

What does Dulos cost?

Because Jesus already paid the cost, Dulos is free. Your only cost is getting to Dulos in Githurai.

Is there housing for Dulos?

Sorry, in an effort to keep this conference free, Dulos can not offer housing. Lunch will be provided, but no other meals.

Why is this conference called Dulos?

In the vernacular of Jesus and the apostles a **Dulos** was a type of slave, but not an ordinary slave that had a life of suffering. A **dulos** was a slave by choice. A **dulos** chose to serve a master that loved and treated his slave well. In return for the good treatment the slave served the master in a higher manner than just enslavement. The life of a **dulos** was a life of joy and fulfillment in doing the will of his master in a cause greater than himself. This is why Paul describes himself as a **dulos** to his Master, Jesus Christ in the book of Phillipians (1:1), which is also a book themed around joy.

What should I bring to Dulos?

Physically you should bring a pen, a notebook or exercise book, and your Bible. Come to **Dulos** expecting to learn. Emotionally you should bring a willing and open spirit without any preconceived ideas about what you will be taught or your purpose for coming. Spiritually come having prayed, possibly even having fasted, and asking God to use this conference to work in and through you to better serve those you minister to. It is hoped that it will be less about what you bring to **Dulos** and more about what God gives you at **Dulos** to transform your ministry.

Can I only come for part of Dulos?

People in the United States and in Kenya have been praying and planning for **Dulos** as a whole teaching. If it is important enough to come, please come for the whole conference. There will not be enough space for all that desire to attend, so please register wisely.

Great, how do I register for Dulos?
